- Publisher PDF = the PDF the publisher makes
- Author PDF = a PDF the author can make
 - should include all editorial changes, such that the content is the same as the Publisher PDF
 - contains the citation information for the Publisher PDF

Open Access Terms




- Gold Open Access = a work published under a copyleft license
- Green Open Access = a work published under traditional publisher copyright, but for which the author self-archives their Author PDF.

• Deposit Author PDF to PubSpace (after 6 months)





 Publisher PDF to PubSpace immediately
- Otherwise deposit Author PDF to PubSpace

- Open access licensing (for a fee): deposit
 Publisher PDF to PubSpace immediately
- Otherwise deposit Publisher PDF to PubSpace after 12 months



JGR Planets, GRL (AGU)



- Open access licensing (for a fee): deposit
 Publisher PDF to PubSpace immediately
- Otherwise deposit Publisher PDF to PubSpace after 6 months
