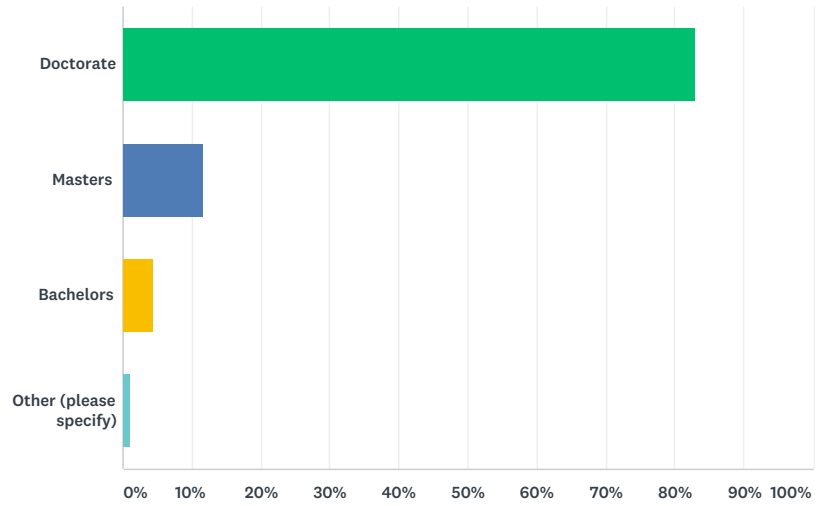

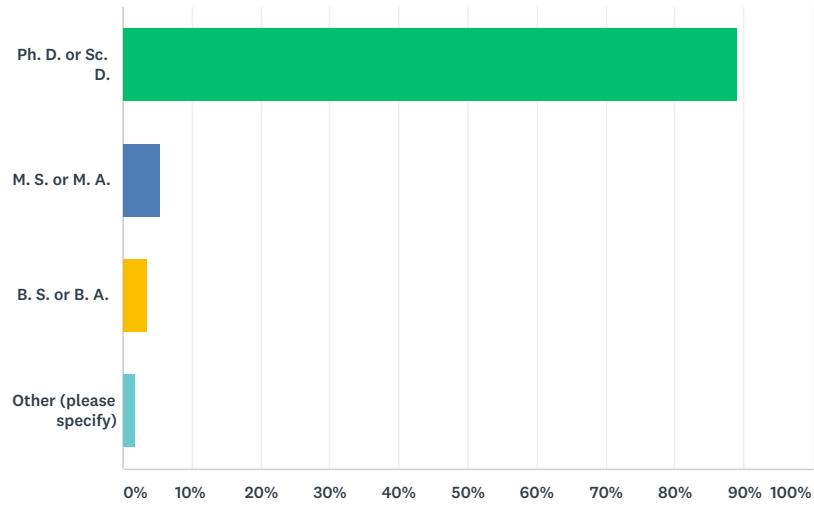

## Q2 If still a student, what is your current degree goal?

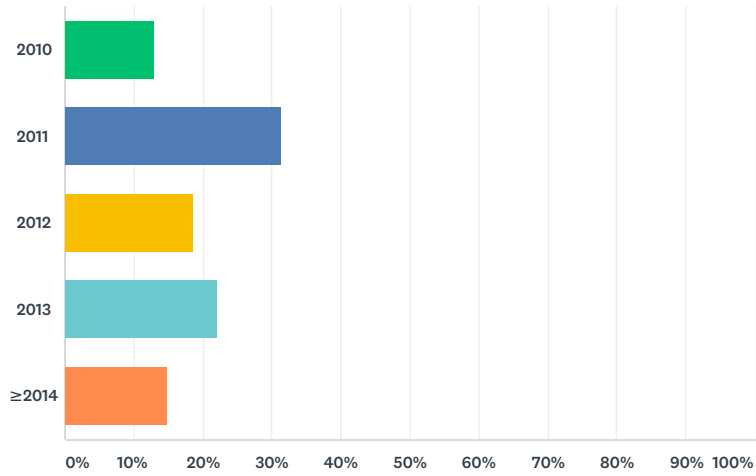

### Q3 If still a student, in what year do you expect to achieve your degree goal?

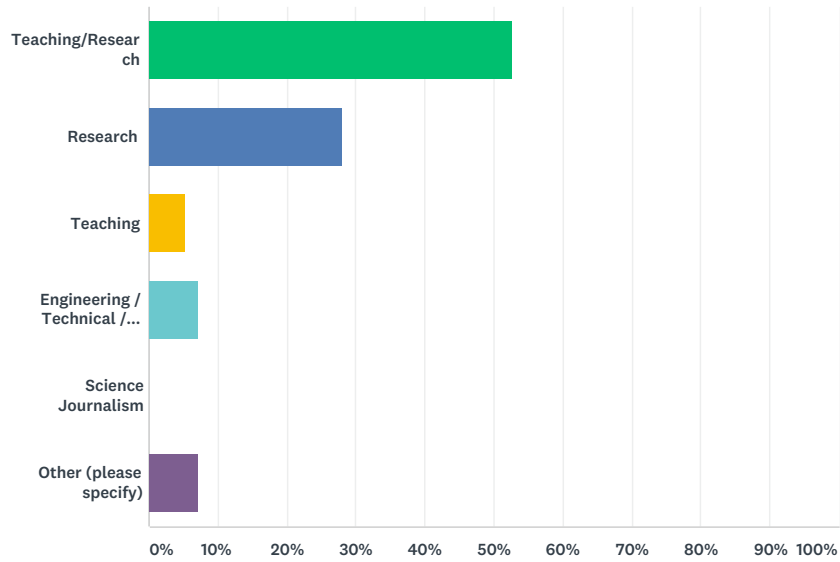

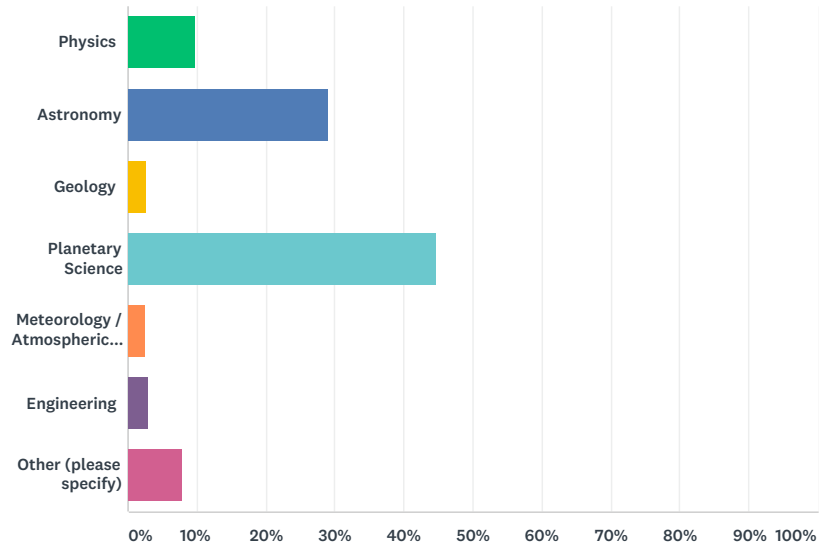

### Q5 What best describes the primary research area of your department or division?

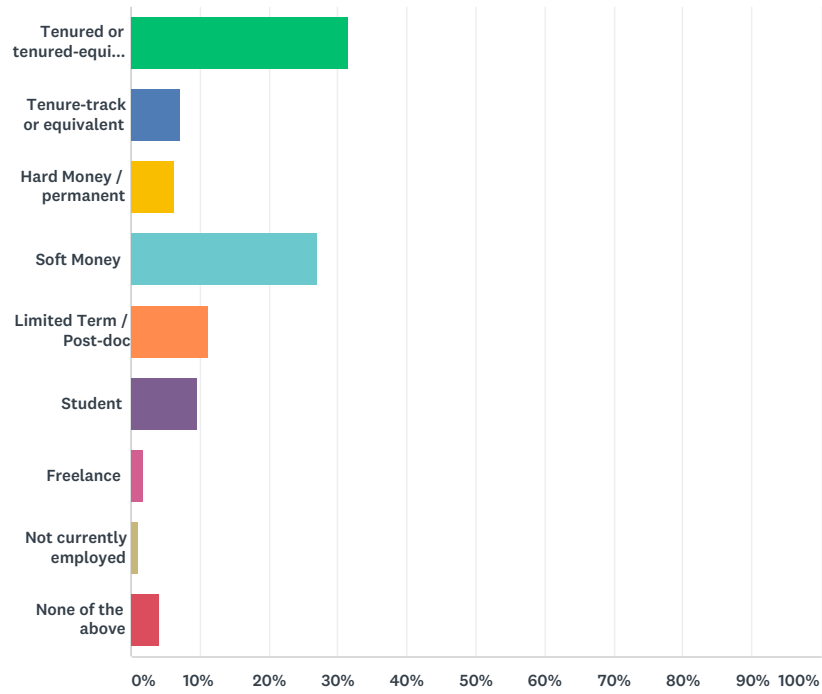

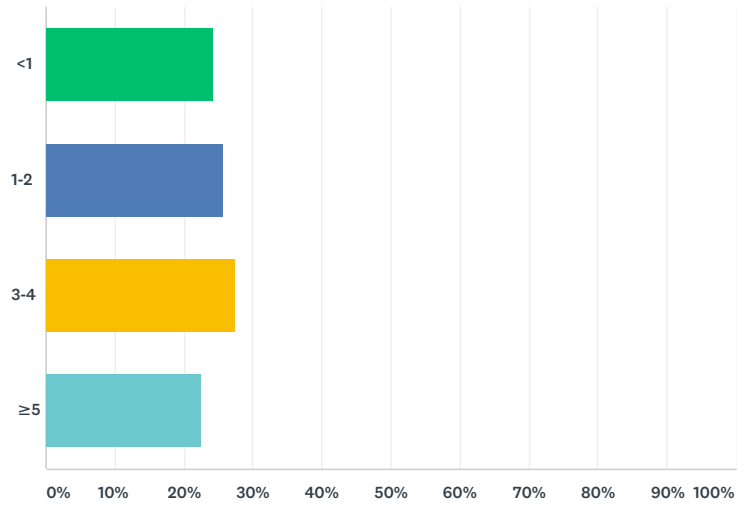

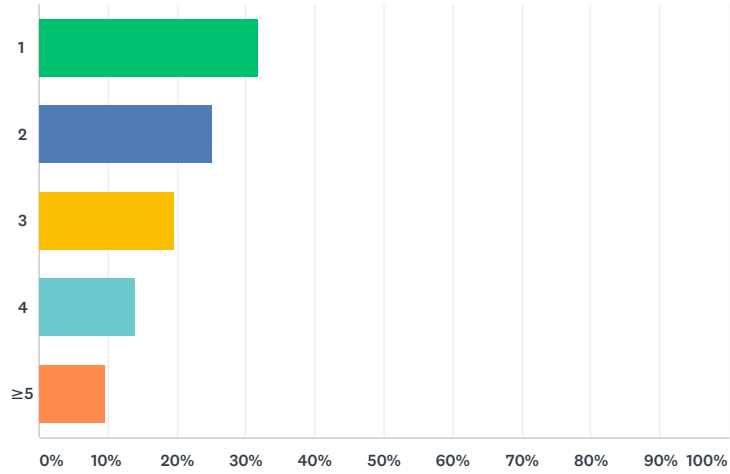

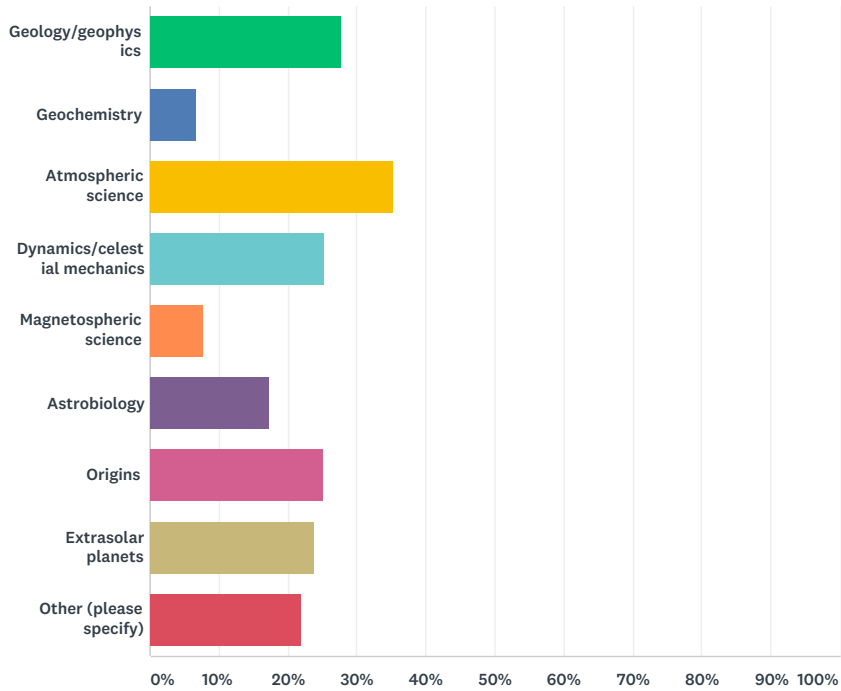

Q9 What are your primary planetary research interests? (Check as many as apply.)

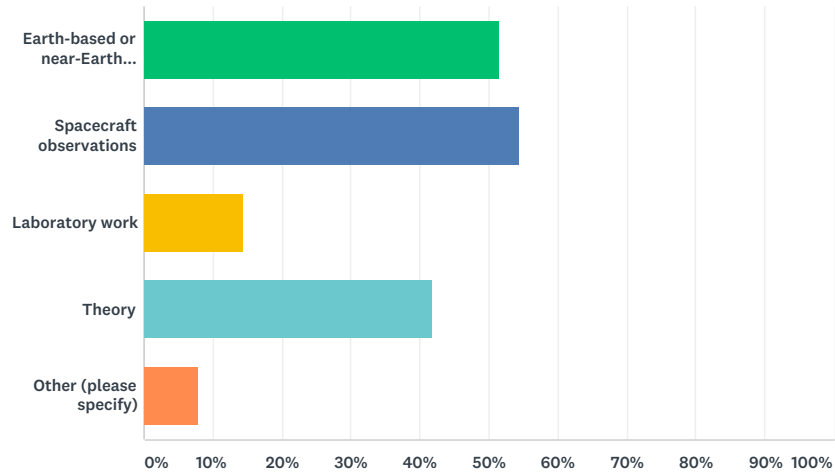

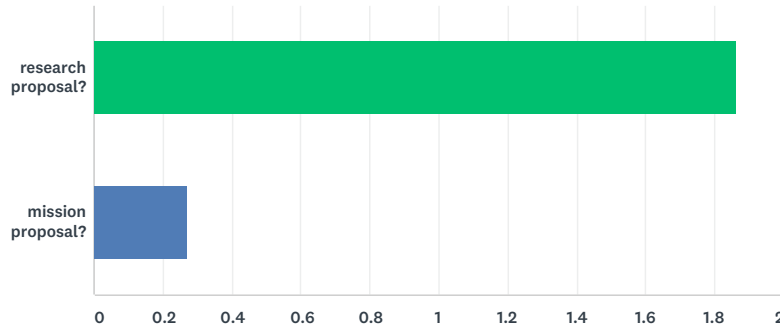

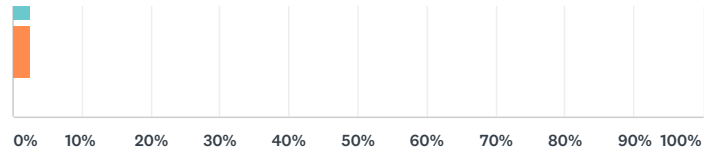
Approximately what percentage of your time is allocated to the following activities?

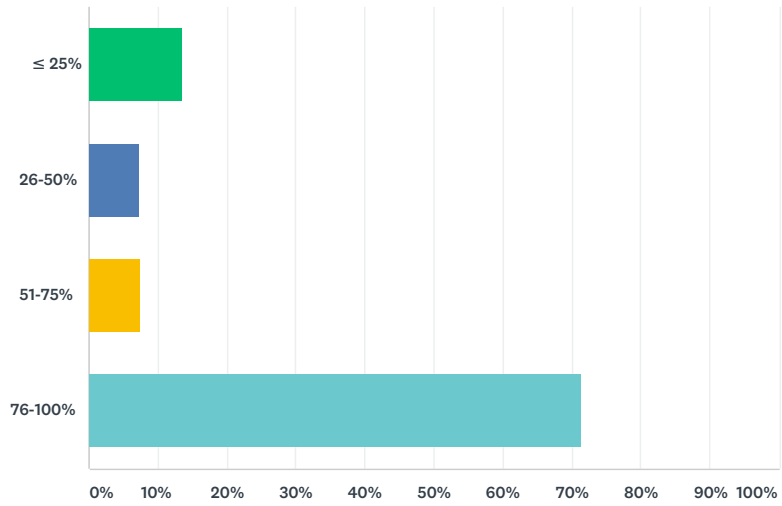

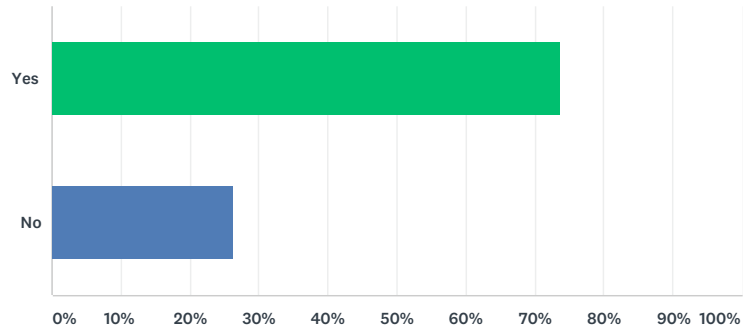

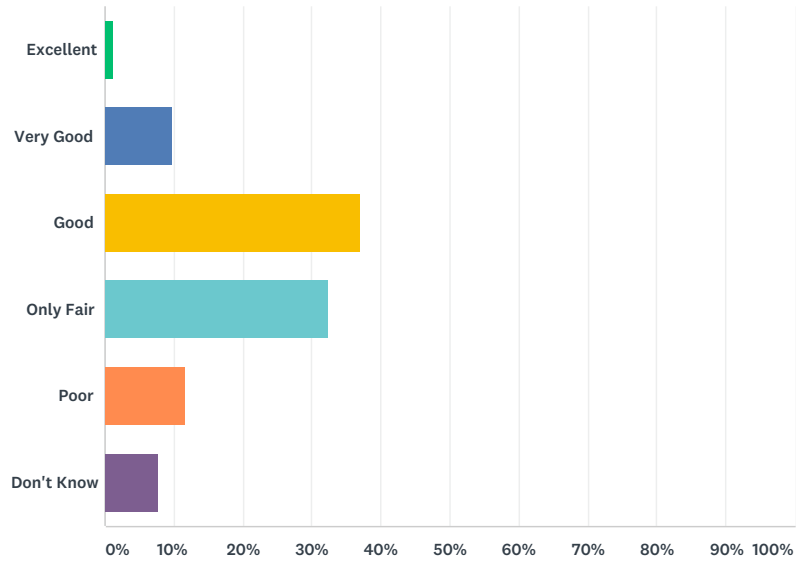

What do you believe are the current employment prospects in planetary science?

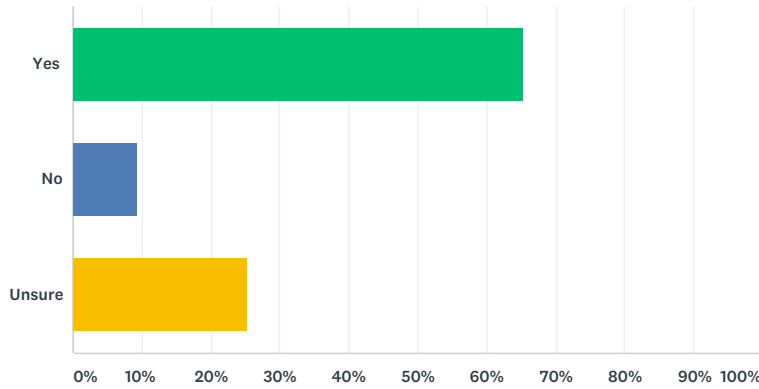

### Q19 Would you encourage talented young people to pursue a career in Planetary Science?

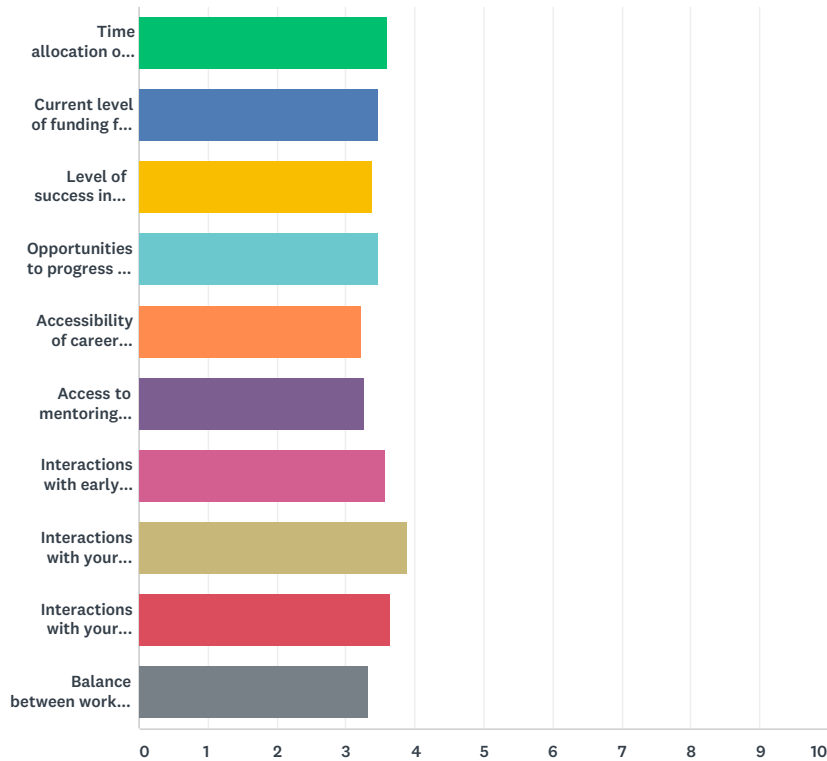

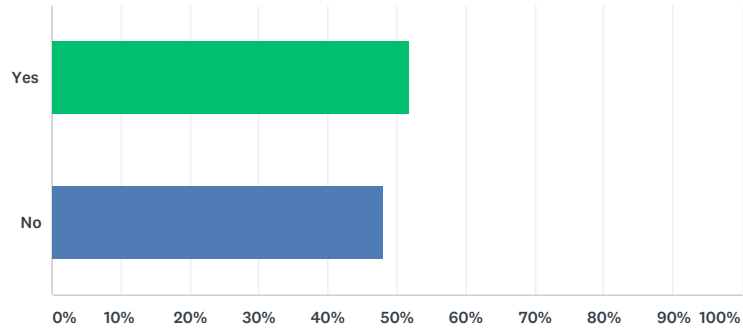

Should the DPS select a small number of inexpensive locations and alternate meetings between them?

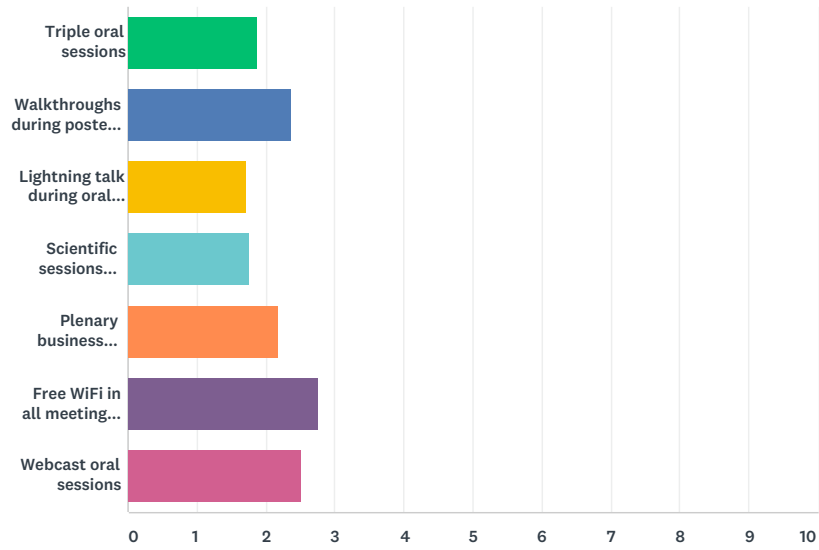

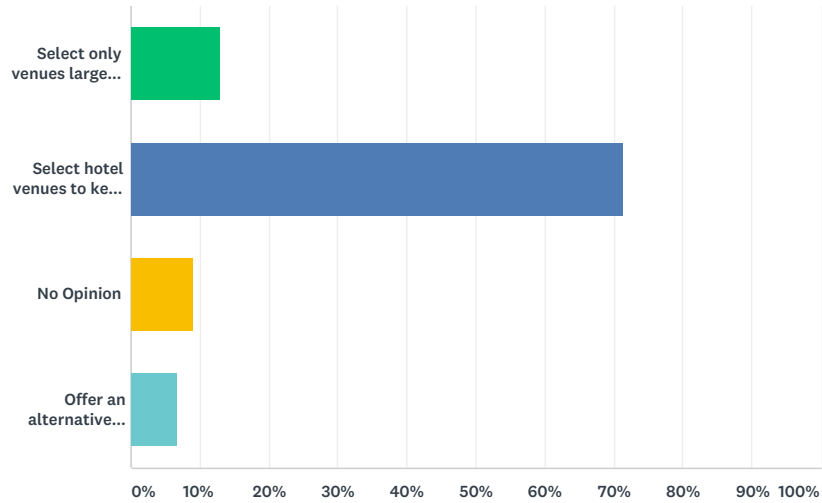

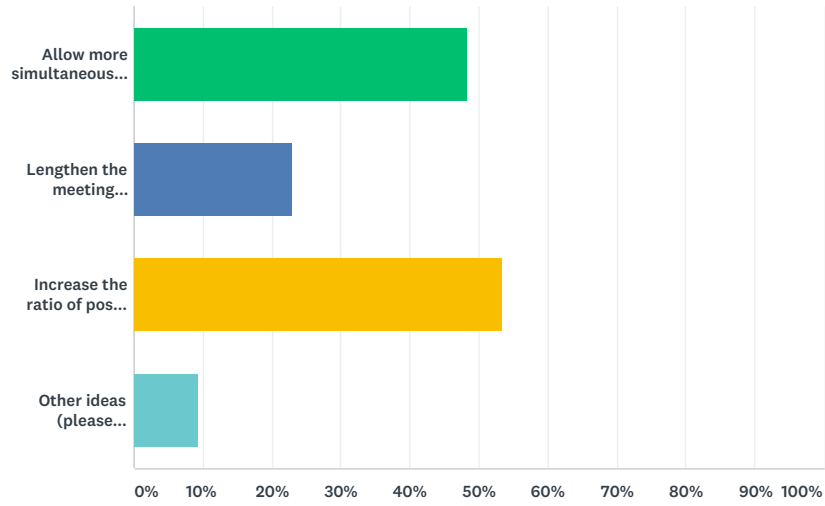

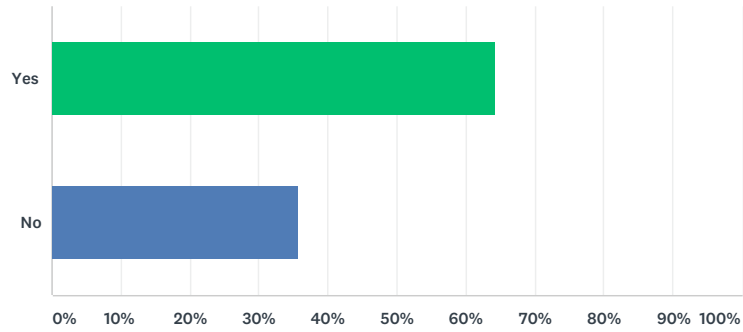

### Q29 Should the Planetary Science community be doing more to reduce the environmental impact of our meetings and other activities?

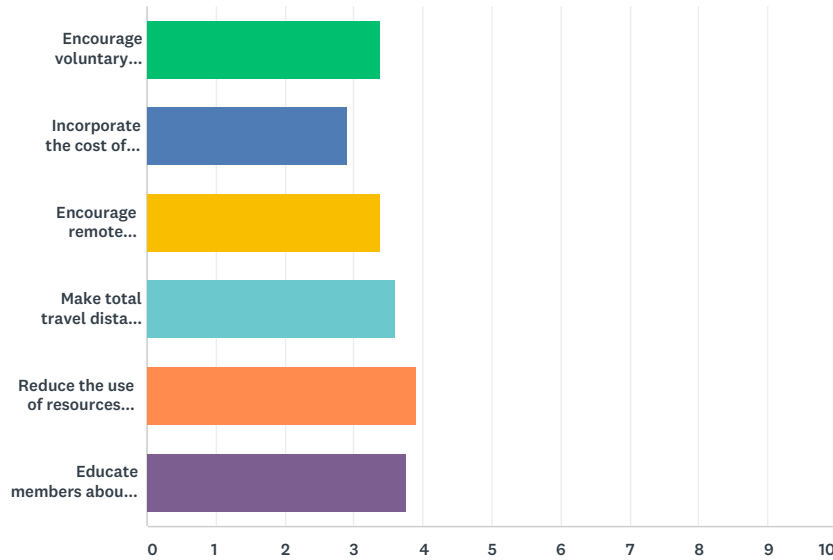

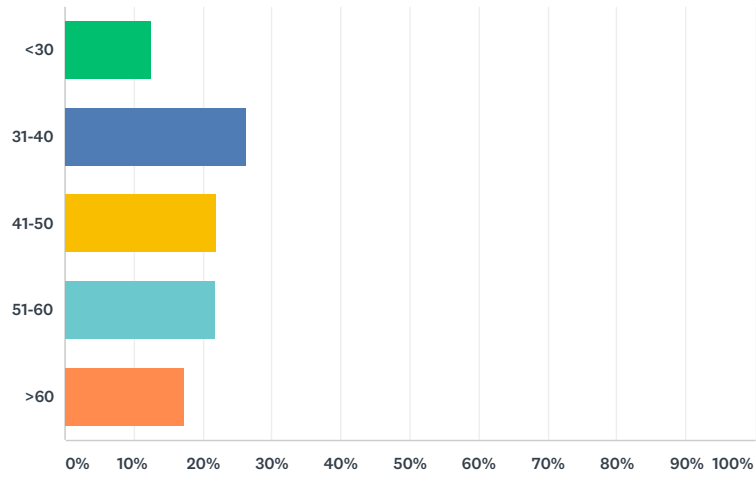

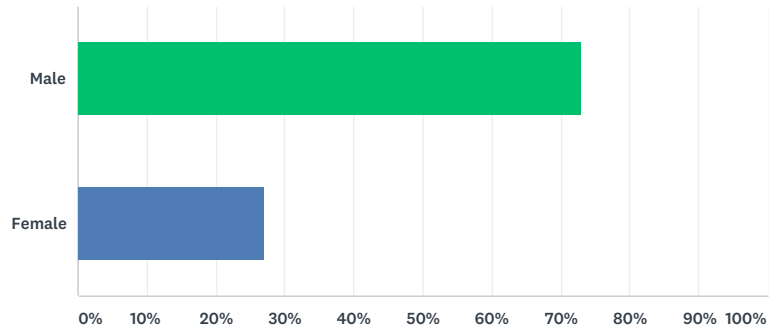

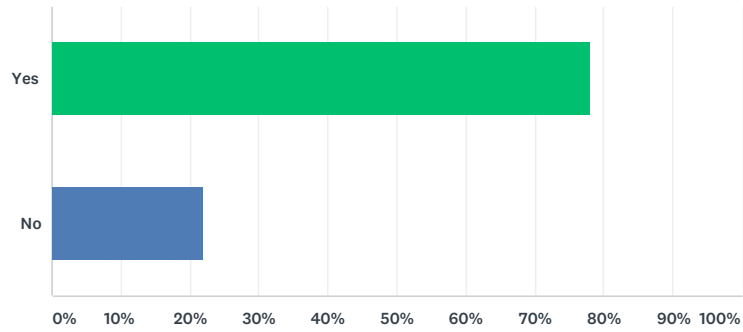

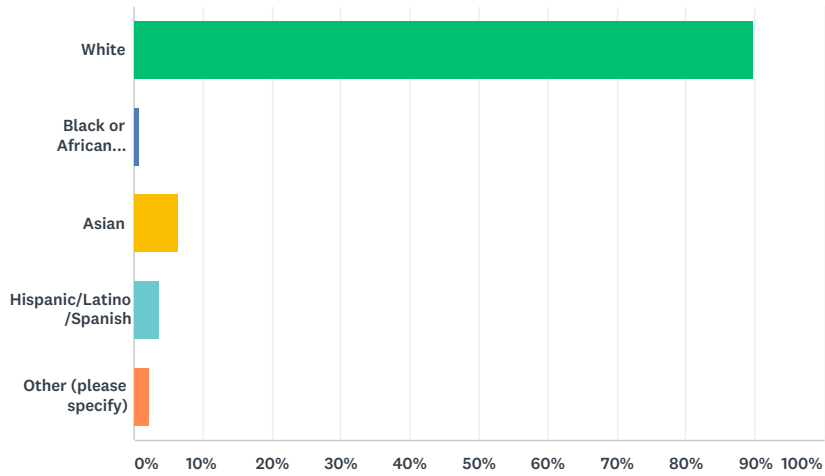

Q34 What is your race/ethnicity? Check all that apply.

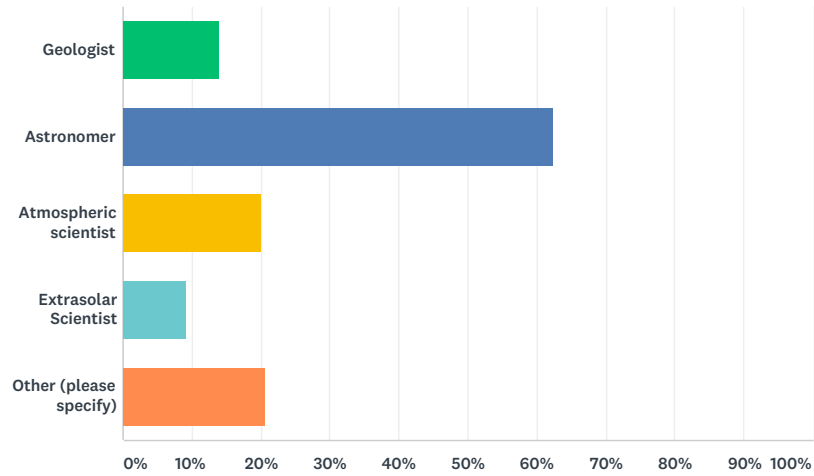

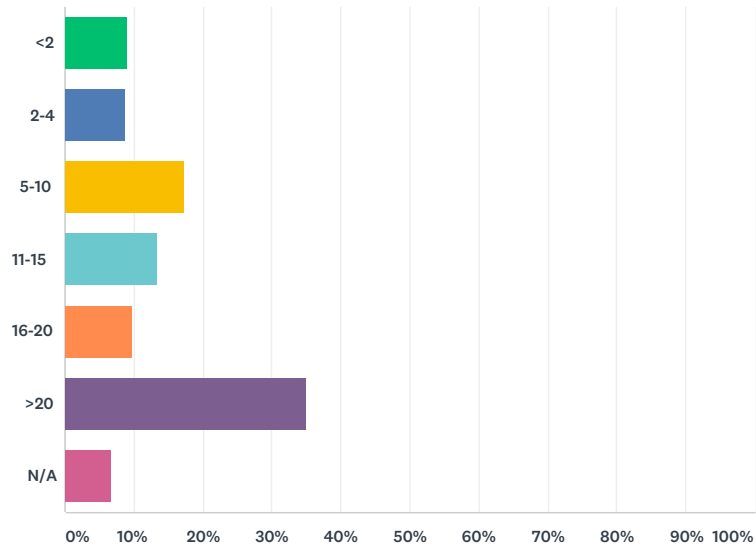

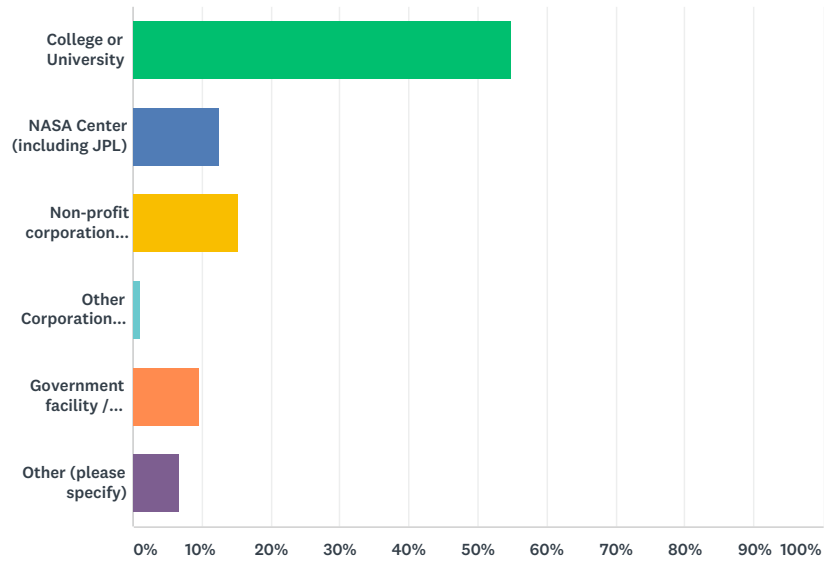

Q37 Which of the following best describes your place of employment?

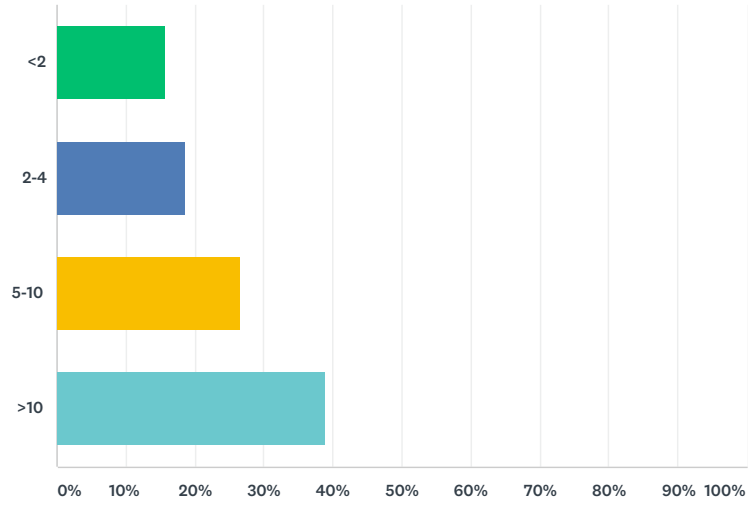
